- 1) Entry deadline is August 6, 2010.
- 2) You must be 18 or older to participate.
- 3) Number of entries **limited to four per person**, one for each season. No more than four entries will be accepted. All entries may be included on one entry form. Holidays can be represented also.
- 4) All entries must be a location in Maine and an outdoor theme (*no people in photographs please*). Both landscape and close-up shots are acceptable. Location must be identified with each entry.
- 5) Photograph submission formats:
 - Only color photographs can be submitted.
 - Electronic format is preferred (jpg, tif), high resolution (*300 dpi or higher*) and sent by e-mail to address below (*not to exceed 10 MB*).
 - If submitting actual photograph, you may deliver it to your local branch or mail to: Photo Contest, Attn: Roxanne Ames, Norway Savings Bank, PO Box 347, Norway, ME 04268-0347. If you would like your photograph(s) returned, you must supply a self-addressed stamped envelope with each photograph.
 - If sending actual photograph(s), please attach a 3 x 5 card to each photo (*no paper clips or staples, removable tape is preferred*). On the 3 x 5 card, write your name, address, phone, e-mail, and location of photo(s). If submitting electronically, e-mail the photo(s) with the above details to photocontest@norwaysavingsbank.com.
- 6) **All contestants must sign a release form** (*located on back of card and at www.norwaysavingsbank.com*) that gives Norway Savings Bank unlimited rights and use of the photos if selected. Photos may also be used in future lobby displays and on Norway Savings Bank's web site, for example. Signed release form must be mailed to: Photo Contest, Attn: Roxanne Ames, Norway Savings Bank, PO Box 347, Norway, ME 04268-0347 and postmarked by August 6, 2010. *Please Note: Norway Savings Bank is not responsible for lost photographs.*
